South African Police Glen Marikana Outreach

Some background on Glen Marikana. This is the settlement situated on Dann Road, next to Glen Ballad Mall. Approximately 2 500 people reside there at the moment. A Kempton Park resident felt in his heart that we should visit the settlement and distribute some bibles. We went to see the commander at SAPS Kempton Park. They bought into the initiative immediately. We then went on to invite all the Spiritual Leaders from our city to accompany us.

On 27 February we had a meeting to discuss logistics and involvement. We found a sponsor who pledged to give 1 000 bibles to be distributed on the day. They chose to remain anonymous.

The elders of this community have agreed to move the settlement to a new piece of land set out for them. The move will take place during October/November this year. We will be accompanying the leaders to their new sight to pray and bless the grounds, and also decide where the new church will be built. Watch this space!
