LIFE COACH TRAINING



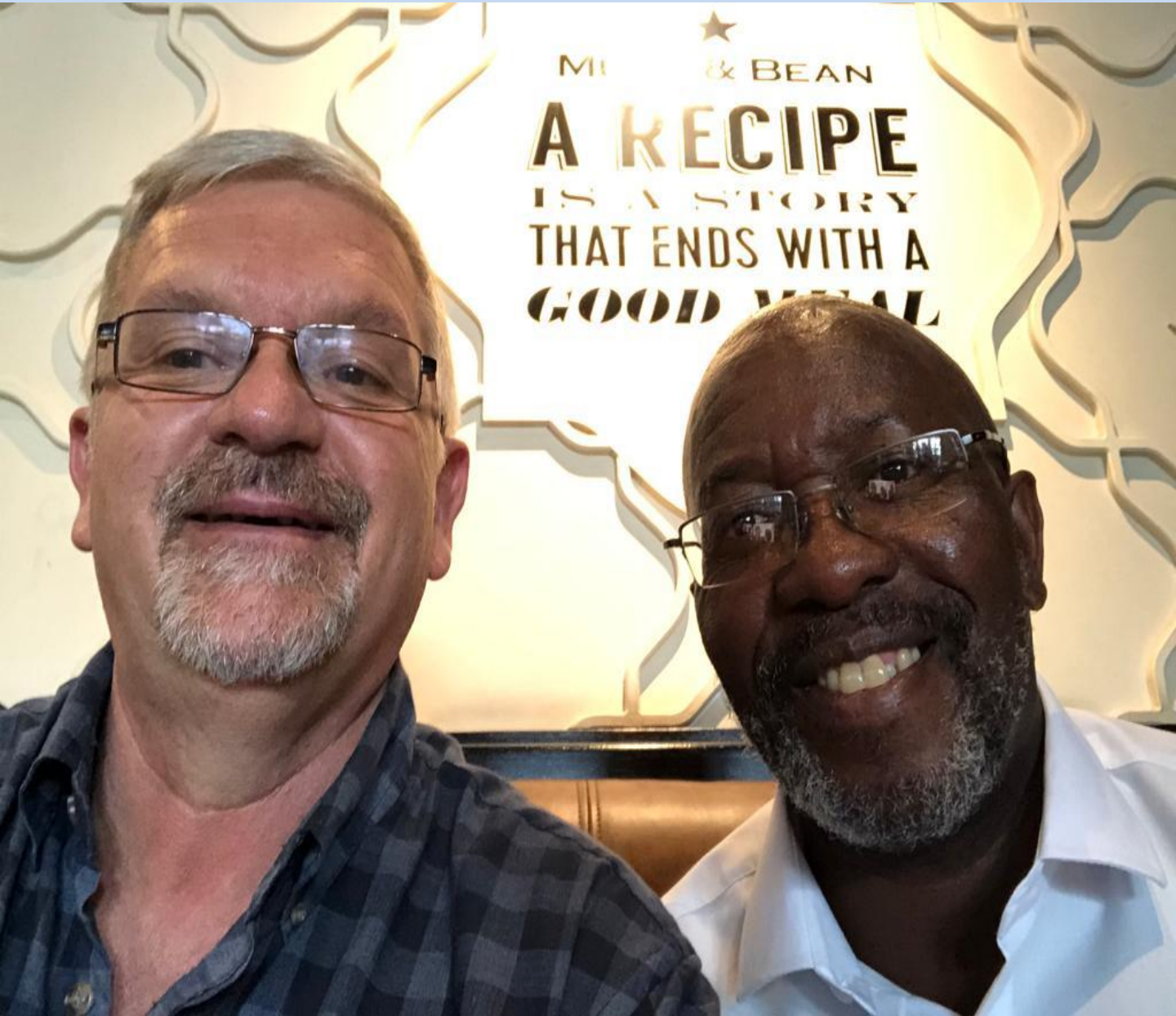

DIRECTIONS TO DESTINY HALFWAY HOUSE

Take the N12 highway towards Witbank.

Drive past the first road sign turn off that shows Ethwatwa.

Exit at the second road sign turn off that shows (R555) Ethwatwa / Springs.

At the Stop street there is a road sign indicating Ethwatwa – Turn Left.

Drive on until you notice the water tower (with scaffolding) at the four way Stop.

Turn Right – Dirt Road – (Approx. 1.8 Km) until you see a small sign to the left, indicating Plot 69.

Turn Left and you will notice the entrance to DESTINY HALFWAY HOUSE
